RE: **ANNUAL NOTIFICATION OF FARMINGTON PUBLIC
SCHOOLS ASBESTOS INSPECTIONS**

This memorandum serves to inform all parents, teachers, administrators and other employees that asbestos reinspections of all buildings as required by AHERA were completed in May of 2009.

Updated Asbestos Management Plans are available for review in the main office of each building. The plan for the Lewis Schulman Administration Building is located in the Purchasing Department at that building.

Any damaged asbestos-containing materials found during the inspections, such as floor tile or thermal insulation, have either been corrected or abated from the District by licensed abatement consultants and/or contractors. All asbestos-containing materials that remain are in good condition and are located primarily in inaccessible areas.

Each building will continue to be inspected every six months, and any damaged asbestos-containing materials will be repaired or removed in accordance with AHERA Guidelines. In addition, AHERA also requires each school district to completely survey all buildings within their jurisdiction and update all asbestos management plans on a three-year schedule. The last three-year inspection was completed in May, 2007.
