The PSAT gives sophomores and juniors an opportunity to:

- Assess verbal and math skills
- Prepare for the SAT. Students can become familiar with the kinds of questions and the exact directions seen on the SAT.
- Compare forecasted SAT scores with the scores of applicants at colleges
- Experience with a college-level standardized test
- Qualify for scholarship programs that use the PSAT results (Juniors only)

You must register for this test between 9/12-9/21 and the cost is \$25. Late registrations will incur a late fee and test availability is not guaranteed. Directions regarding the registration process will be made on listserv and PA announcements. After students register, you can pick up a PSAT guide with a sample practice test from Ms Palmer in the Media Center Office. Note: Refunds must be requested in writing or the entire registration fee will be forfeited. Cancellation forms are available in Ms. Palmer's office in the media center to receive a refund of \$15.
