

LINK CREW FRESHMAN CELEBRATION CLASS OF 2014

The staff and students at Harrison High School invite the Class of 2014 to our third annual **Link Crew Freshmen Celebration**. The program runs from **8:00 am – 11:45 am on Thursday, Sept. 2, 2010 in the gymnasium** (located on the southeast corner of the school).

The Link Crew Freshman Celebration Day and transition program is designed to both welcome and support freshmen by assigning them a junior or senior Link Leader as a mentor during this first year. This Link Leader is a responsible older student who was hand selected from a large pool of applicants and has met the qualification of being a good role model and a positive leader on our campus. Following is some information to let you know what you and your student can expect in advance of their first day of school.

1. A day or two before Celebration Day (Sept. 2) your student will receive a phone call from her or his Link Crew Leader personally inviting him to Celebration Day and giving the details of where to be and what time.
2. Freshmen will meet their "crew" of two leaders and nine other freshmen, participate in both large and small group activities, receive their schedule, and take a very entertaining school tour.
3. Because the day is very active, your student is encouraged to wear comfortable clothes and not to bring backpacks, purses, etc.
4. Food will NOT be served, so please make sure that a good breakfast is eaten.
5. This is a student only function so we encourage you to let your child attend on her or his own.
6. On the first day of school, (Tuesday, Sept. 7th), Link Crew Leaders will be wearing their purple shirts to assist any freshmen needs or concerns.
