## Discipline-

## Quizzes:

Each week, a 25 point quiz will be given. The testing format will be either written or practical. The quiz will test your understanding of the content learned during that particular week. Each quiz will be calculated as part of your participation grade for the week.

## Attendance Policy-

**Tardiness** – will affect your daily grade. Students need to be in their designated attendance spot **by the time bell rings**. If you are not in your assigned location at the time of the bell, you will be considered tardy. **In addition, you are given 5 minutes to change in the locker room, and if you exit late, you are also considered to be tardy.**

**Excused Tardy** – if you have an excused tardy, you will not be allowed to enter the lock room to change without proper supervision. The instructor will not escort a student into the locker room once class has begun. The excused tardy will be used against the allotment of **3 excused absences/tardies per term**. Class can be made up according to the PE Policy Guidelines.

Unexcused Tardy – you may be allowed to enter the locker room if the class has not already changed, but you are subject to the school code of conduct and a detention will be assigned.

**\*\*If you are later than 15 minutes, you are considered absent.**

Excused Absence- if you have a school approved absence, you will be considered excused.

**\*\*\*You are allowed 3 before you must make up the participation time missed.\*\*\***

Make-ups must be arranged with the instructor. You will have 3 weeks from the date of absence to make up any missed work/time.
