

Farmington PTA Offers Bridges Math Parent Forum November 28 at Highmeadow Common Campus

Farmington, Michigan – On Monday, November 28, at Highmeadow Common Campus, the Farmington PTA Council will be holding a Bridges Math Forum for parents. Bridges is the math program in the District for grades K-5.

Farmington Public Schools' math coordinators and teachers will conduct the Forum so that parents can better understand the math program. The Forum will begin with an overview of the math program presented by the District's math coordinators. Parents will then have an opportunity to go to a classroom and see Bridges math in action. A teacher from each K-5 level throughout the District will present exercises demonstrating how Bridges math is taught to students.
