Farmington, Michigan—The International Diploma Baccalaureate Programme is an internationally recognized two-year program that begins in the 11th grade. Preparation for the Diploma Programme begins in the ninth grade. IB offers a comprehensive curriculum and a teaching philosophy aimed at developing the whole child emphasizing intellectual, personal, emotional and social growth through all domains of knowledge. IB students become active learners as all courses encourage students to understand how they learn, how they connect learning, and how they apply learning. Upon completion of the Diploma Programme, each student will have a rigorous pre-university education, which is accepted as an entrance qualification for higher education in more than 60 sixty countries around the world.
